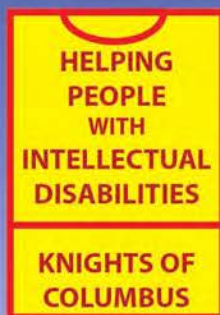

STATE TREASURER REPORT

It has been my privilege and honor to serve you as your State Treasurer for a portion of Columbian Year 2017-2018. I assumed the office mid-year and found the books to be in order and good accounting practices to be in place. The State Council operates in much the same way as a local Council with receipts and vouchers serving to authorize and document all financial transactions as part of the permanent record. Similar to Council Trustees, transactions are routinely reviewed by the State Administrative and Finance Committee; consisting of the Immediate Past State Deputy, State Deputy, State Secretary, State Treasurer and two 3rd Degree members at large.

All income and expenditures (with exception of atypical pass through charitable contributions and disaster relief) are governed by an annual budget voted on and approved by council delegates attending State Convention in the preceding year. The budget is divided into roughly four sections; State Council Operation (travel, events and ceremonials), State Office Operation (rent, utilities, postage and business machine operation), State Programs (membership, faith, family and charitable activities) and expenses related to hosting the Annual State Convention. Earnings from monies held by the Supreme Council Christopher Fund also serve to provide annual contributions to the 12 California Dioceses and Archdioceses each year.

The budget for the coming year will be presented at this 2018 Annual State Convention in Sacramento and I suggest you look it over carefully. There has been a concerted effort to reduce overall state per capita costs in recent years.

I would like to extend my deepest congratulations and gratitude to our Worthy State Deputy Romeo Quevedo, Worthy State Secretary Joseph Salaiz and Worthy Supreme Membership Program Consultant Patrick Maloney, as well as all the State Officers and Committeemen both past and present for their guidance and advice. A very special thanks also to our Administrative Assistant, Danalynn Hays, for her continued dedication, support and assistance to our State and Order.



MEMBERSHIP DIRECTOR'S REPORT

At the time of this writing we are three-quarters of the way through the Columbian Year and the membership statistics for California stand thus: 2,454 members recruited or reactivated – 1,026 members suspended or withdrawn – for a net gain of 1,428 members. There are currently 76,410 members in the State of California which is the eighth largest jurisdiction in the Order.

Join me in congratulating and extending a warm welcome to the newest councils in the state: St. Andrew Council 16832 in Pasadena, newly reinstituted Our Lady of Guadalupe San Bernardino Council 2132 in Ontario, and newly reactivated Resurrection San Juan Council 11269 in Los Angeles. My thanks go to District Deputy David Ramos, Hispanic Development Coordinator Jose "Pona" Magana and everyone who worked so tirelessly on these projects.

We mourn the loss of State Membership Director Matthew McDonagh who passed away unexpectedly in February of this year. His vision for membership recruitment and growing the Order was quite simple: "Each of us by virtue of our shared faith and values exists to help every council in California grow and sustain its membership creating an environment which attracts all Catholic men to serve their Church, community, and fellow man through the Knights of Columbus." History of the Holy Angels Council 10948

Holy Angels Council 10948 had its beginning in early 1992, when at the request of then Associate Pastor Rev. John Mark Marrald with the permission of Pastor Rev. Fr. John Cloherty; Knight of Columbus District Deputy Al LaToracca and Holy Angels parishioners led by charter Grand Knight Vincent Pacis worked relentlessly to form a local council. The initial exemplification's into the first degree was held on May 24, 1992 with eleven candidates. On October 3, 1992, the Knights of Columbus Supreme Council issued Holy Angels Council No. 10948 its charter. Coincidentally, the installation of the charter officers was also held on October 3, 1992. Forty charter members (30 new and 10 transfers) eagerly learned and transformed themselves into Knights of Columbus.

The following year, in its first year of existence, Holy Angels Council with Grand Knight Vincent Pacis leadership achieved the coveted Star Council award. That started and remained an unbroken tradition by every Grand Knight that followed him that the council always strived for an award from the State and Supreme Councils. The council has become one of the best among the 692 councils in the state and was recognized with the California Best Service Program Award earned under the direction of Grand Knight Ruben Sy in 1998 and the California Best Council Award in 1999 with Grand Knight Ed Vocal at the helm.

The awards kept coming every year with the Star Council Award or the Prestigious McGivney award or one of the service program awards in Community, Family, Youth, Culture of life, Church, and Council categories or recognition from the ID Drive, the Wheelchair Mission and other charity foundations supported by the council,

The council had developed and provided many leaders for the Order. Special mention for this recognition is the election of PGK Sir Knight Vincent Pacis to State Deputy in 2009-2010, the highest elected office in the state. Later he was recognized and appointed by the Supreme Knight Carl Anderson to the prestigious position of Supreme Membership and Program Consultant for the Philippines, which is made up of four separate growing jurisdictions of the Order. Numerous Past Grand Knights have served as District Deputies, Chapter Presidents and are still active in many state standing committees that help run the Order in California. Among them is PGK Sir Knight Greg Marracq who also was a Former District Deputy, Past President of the St. Francis Chapter and currently the Chairman for the State Convention for next May 2018 a position that has put Holy Angels council in the fore front of the State Council activities this year.

Such is the tradition of excellence that started 25 years ago here in Colma, California; the local council had produced more than 250 worthy Knights of Columbus and is still going strong and producing a second generation of Knights who were just young kids when the council was started.
