WHEREAS, Brother Stephen E. Bolton has provided the leadership within the Southern California Special Olympics community for over 39 years servicing and supporting the Fall, Spring and Summer Games and numerous Special Olympics events. Recognized as Volunteer of the Year for Southern California Special Olympics in 2008 and as Orange County Volunteer Person of the Year in 2012. Currently serving as Chair for RLC in Orange County; and
