

 Columbian Retirement Center and Abbey of Our Lady of New Clairvaux - \$80.00 per person

Visit the Knights of Columbus retirement facility "Columbian Retirement Center" in Marysville, a small community 50 miles north of Sacramento. The Center is an independent living Center, a home away from home, owned and operated by the Knights of Columbus. A tour of the Center, then a tour of St. Joseph's Catholic Church across the street will certainly build an appetite for our lunch provided by the Marysville Knights of Columbus in the Church Hall.

We leave Marysville and head to Vina for a tour of The Abbey of Our Lady of New Clairvaux along with a tour of the unique winery and tasting room which will include five tastings. In 1955, this lovely Trappist-Cistercian Abbey was founded in the small peaceful town of Vina. Located on 600 acres of beautiful orchards and vineyards, the Abbey is farmed by the monks to provide their sustenance. The property is home to a completely restored 12<sup>th</sup> century "Chapter House" that was originally part of the Santa Maria de Ovila Cistercian Abbey in Spain. The Chapter House is the largest example of original Cistercian-Gothic architecture in the Western Hemisphere, and the oldest building in the United States west of the Mississippi.

Your coach will leave the DoubleTree Hotel at 9:00 am and arrive back around 5:00 pm in time for Thursday evening's welcome party.


You will receive a \$5.00 player card on arrival.

Your coach will leave the DoubleTree Hotel at 9:30am after Mass and return by 3:00pm.

You will enjoy a sight-seeing tour of Sacramento on your motor coach, including the State Capitol Building, Sutter's Fort, and the Fabulous 40s. A visit to the Man of Shroud Exhibit, which is on display at the National Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe, will be our first stop. This is just one of a handful of exhibits featuring the history of the famous Shroud of Turin. The exhibit focuses on the known history of the Shroud. Replicas of artwork dating back to the 11<sup>th</sup> century chronicle the travels of the artifact from Byzantine times to the modern era.

We will then head to Old Sacramento where you will be dropped off to explore Old Sacramento at your leisure. This national historic landmark overflows with things to see and do. Dozens of locally-owned small shops, with novel gifts, delightful treats and upscale accessories and apparel. It's home to numerous museums, including the Sacramento History Museum, the state Railroad Museum, and the California Automobile Museum. Stop for lunch or a treat at one of the many eating establishments. Lunch is not included.
