## Objectives –

## Description of the Program –

1. Each Brother Knight is invited to visit each of the 21 California Missions. Wives, families, and friends are encouraged to join.
2. The State Council will work with the respective chapters and councils to promote a featured event at each mission where Brother Knights can participate and at the same time visit the mission. 3. Brother Knights may visit the missions any day that these are open. Please check their websites or call before visiting. As the Brother Knights visit each mission, he should have his "mission passport" stamped. The passport may be obtained at the first mission visited. If for some reason a stamp cannot be obtained (e. g. store or gift shop is closed), Brother Knights should take a photo of himself with the mission in the background.



4. At the end of the Columbian year, every Brother Knight who visited all 21 California Missions will be entered into a drawing.
