


The California Knights of Columbus State Council will hold their 121st State Annual Meeting (Formerly State Convention) in the City of Ontario from May 18 – 20, 2023 at the Ontario DoubleTree. This hotel will provide all the event functions, other than the tours on that Thursday and Friday.

The theme of this year's State Annual Meeting is "Siempre Adelante, Nunca Atras!" (Always Forward, Never Back).

It is my great pleasure to invite you and your families and guests to attend the largest statewide gathering of Knights and their families each year. The State Annual Meeting Planning Committee is planning an outstanding weekend for your enjoyment.

We have a special Thursday tour lined up to visit the Emilio B. Moure Museum at the State Office in Fontana and the Blessed Michael McGivney Statue Project. 


Honor Guard members from throughout California are encouraged to bring their regalia and schedule time to participate in the Mass processions and to stand post at the Chapel.

Come and view the newly dedicated statue of our founder, Blessed Father Michael McGivney, our new chapel, and of course, the Museum. On display at our home in the State Office we will have the mannequins dressed in the three generations of Fourth Degree regalia, newspapers dating back to the early 1900's, photographs, artifacts, icons of Past State Deputies, and many other interesting items relating to the history of the Knights of Columbus in California.
