Why do we push this so hard?

Currently California has 2,725 members in the State Online Council #98004.

1,951 of them are assigned to councils. What does this mean?

That's 1,951 members wanting and waiting to join a council.

That could be hundreds of Council intake quotas met and hundreds of Star Councils.

What's the holdup on getting them converted?

Council Retention

Keep them Active

Nobody joined to do nothing, give them a job, a stake in the council.

Cor is the best tool we have for retention and reactivation.

Keep them Recruiting

Every Council needs new blood. New ideas. Many hands makes light work.

Keep them Paid-up

A Council is suspended when they don't pay their bills.

144 Councils are Suspend, 81 just this past year.

Suspended Councils & Reactivating

What is the quickest way to get them back?

- Those recently suspended only need to pay their bills.
- Council suspended for a couple years need some work.
- Councils suspended for many years need additional work...like starting new Council.



Know that some simply wont or can't be reactivated.

Note this on your next 944 report and they will be moved to Council Affiliate.
