### **Spiritual Reflections**

Under the guidance of their chaplain, councils can attend a retreat or day of reflection together or organize their own event for the men of their parish. These events may be open only to council members or men of the parish – or may be open to entire families. If councils are unable to organize these events themselves, they could go attend an existing retreat as a group.
