



Star Tracker, Fraternal Year 2021-2022



STAR COUNCIL / STAR TRACKER

- **Why do you want to be a STAR Council?**
 - I'm not in it for the Awards
 - My Councils don't meet regularly
 - Many other excuses
- **What happens when you achieve STAR Council?**
 - Council Pride goes way up
 - DD should announce in Parish bulletin every STAR Council
 - Recruiting becomes easier
 - Parishioners applaud you, and they want to attend your events
- **What is STAR Council?**
 - It is the recognition of a fully functioning Council. Councils that show they are truly supportive of the church, and the fellow men of the Parish.
- **Who has achieved STAR Council? Or STAR District?**
 - In CA, during 2022-23, there were approx. 13.5% of the Councils
 - In CA, during 2023-24, goal was to have 102 STAR Councils, or 14.2%
- **Does the DD affect the outcome of a Council getting STAR?**
 - Absolutely. You are the Coach, and the STAR TRACKER is your tool.
 - If you bring the STAR TRACKER to every Council visit, you will emphasize the importance of reaching STAR.
- **How do you achieve STAR Council?**
 - **Fr McGivney Award** – For Membership Growth
 - **Columbian Award** – For Faith in Action 16 Activities
 - **Founders' Award** – For promoting the Fraternal Benefits
 - **Overall Reports and SE** – For being on time with reports and Safe Environment Compliant by Officers
- **How do you read the STAR TRACKER Report and how often is it published?**
 - **STAR TRACKER** comes out twice a month, usually on the 15th and last day. It is also on the State website at CaliforniaKnights.org
 - **Review the Report with Council Officers.**
 - **RED** – Get the Red Out. If Pink, we have a name, but missing something
 - **SAFE ENVIRONMENT** – Triggered by the 365 Form. Then you have 30-45 days to complete training. How do you monitor? Go to DD Reports on Home page. KofC.org. If you miss the 45 days, put in a new Form 365.
- **EXPECTED PROGRESS –**
 - **185/365** – Due July 1. Therefore Safe Environment is due August 1.
 - **FBN** – First one should be done by October 1. Best format is to do a Council group BBQ, and invite the Parish to join.
 - **New Members** – You should be at 50% by October 15. Schedule your CUFs in advance and have a Church Drive one week before.

A council must submit a *Columbian Award Application (#SP7)* listing a total of 16 program credits to earn the Columbian Award. Faith in Action Featured Programs count for two credits. All other council programs count for one credit.

Columbian Award Program Reporting Guidelines

The following criteria must be met for programs to count towards Columbian Award program credits:

- Programs must be *organized by the council or involve significant participation by council members* to qualify. Program descriptions should reference how they meet these criteria.
- Programs must engage members by enhancing faith and spirituality, serving a charitable purpose, or a combination of the two. Program descriptions should reference how they meet these criteria.
- Councils must earn at least four (4) program credits in each of the Faith in Action categories: Faith, Family, Community, and Life. Refer to the [Faith in Action Guidebook](#) or visit kofc.org/faithinaction for more information on programs.
- Two program credits can be earned for programs meeting [Featured Program Minimum Requirements](#). All non-featured programs and programs not meeting minimum requirements earn 1 program credit.
- Donations alone do not qualify unless they result from the council's fundraising activities or are for a Faith in Action program activity (i.e., Ultrasound Initiative, Global Wheelchair Mission, etc.). If a donation is made for a non-Faith in Action program or no fundraising activities were carried out by the council, the council must also report non-monetary support to qualify.
- Participating or volunteering for standard liturgical functions generally does not qualify for program credit. Examples of non-qualifying activities include attending or serving at Mass or funerals, ushering, or participating as a "Eucharistic Minister", lector, choir member, etc.
- Programs taking place during *Cor*, such as Holy Hour, the Rosary Program, Men of the Word Bible Study, *Into the Breach*, etc., qualify for credit. However, *Cor* itself does not qualify for program credit.
- Refer to the sample [Sample Columbian Award Application](#) for an example of an acceptable form.

*Fraternal Mission staff reserves the right to determine whether programs
qualify for program credit based on these criteria.*



Featured Programs

Minimum Requirements

FEATURED PROGRAMS

The Supreme Council has designated select programs as featured programs in each of the four program categories. When your council conducts a featured program and satisfies the associated requirements it will receive two credits towards that program category on the [Columbian Award Application](#) (#SP-7). At the end of the year, report all completed programs on the *Annual Survey of Fraternal Activity* (#1728). For additional Featured Program information, review the individual program guide sheets found at kofc.org/fiaresources. All program forms may be found at kofc.org/fiaforms.

FAITH

REFUND SUPPORT VOCATIONS PROGRAM (RSVP)

Councils are required to donate at least \$500 to an individual seminarian or religious aspirant. For every \$500 donated, Supreme will refund the council or assembly \$100, with a maximum refund of \$400 per individual supported. Report activity using the [RSVP Refund Application](#) (#2863).

HOLY HOUR

Councils are required to hold at least four Holy Hours (quarterly) or organize and support two Holy Hours and at least one Eucharistic Procession. Report activity using the [Program Report Form](#) (#10784).

INTO THE BREACH

Councils are required to hold eight sessions to discuss the content of the original *Into the Breach* video series or apostolic exhortation (#340) or five sessions of *Into the Breach: The Mission of the Family* video series. Report activity using the [Program Report Form](#) (#10784).

SPIRITUAL REFLECTION

Councils are required to host or attend a Spiritual Reflection for the men of the council and the parish that is at least a day long and is attended by 10 men or 10% of your council, whichever is fewer. Report activity using the [Program Report Form](#) (#10784).

FAMILY

FOOD FOR FAMILIES

Councils are required to collect a minimum of \$500 or 1,000 pounds of food for a parish or community food pantry. In addition, councils must contribute a minimum of 100 total man-hours in preparation/distribution/service of meals. Report activity using the [Food for Families Refund and Plaque Application](#) (#10057).

FAMILY OF THE MONTH/YEAR

Councils are required to recognize twelve families throughout the fraternal year: one for each month. In addition, each council should submit a Family of the Year to their jurisdiction's competition. Report activity using the [Program Report Form](#) (#10784) and the [Family of the Year Entry Form](#) (#10680).



ULTRASOUND

Councils are required to identify a Pregnancy Center in need of an ultrasound machine that meets the requirements listed on the [Diocesan Evaluation](#) (#10715). Upon approval from the Supreme Council, a council raises 50% of the cost of the ultrasound machine. The council must then follow the published guidelines for obtaining the remaining 50% from the Supreme Council. Qualification for this program will be determined from the information provided on both the [Diocesan Evaluation](#) (#10715) and the [Ultrasound Application](#) (#10716).

All programs are separate and cannot be double-counted.

*Example: The Into the Breach program cannot be conducted in order to **also** satisfy the program requirements for the Building the Domestic Church Kiosk program, etc.*
