

 - ➤ Milpitas Council starts "Tootsie Roll Drive" in 1982
 - Orange County supports respite home at Bishop Johnson's requests in early 80s
- Resolution to make "Tootsie Roll Drive" a statewide program adopted at 1986 Convention
- 501c(3) Columbian Foundation established in 1987 with PSD Frank Nigro as first President
- To date California councils have raised over \$22,000,000.00 in support of this program






