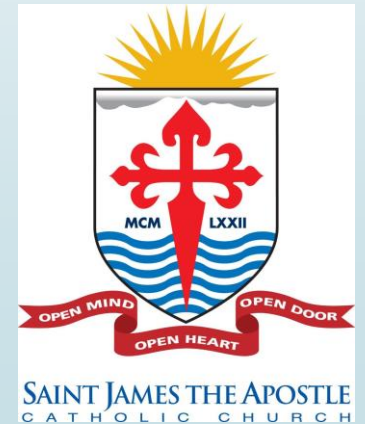


NOVENA FOR THE SICK AND FOR FR. REY REYES' INTENTION

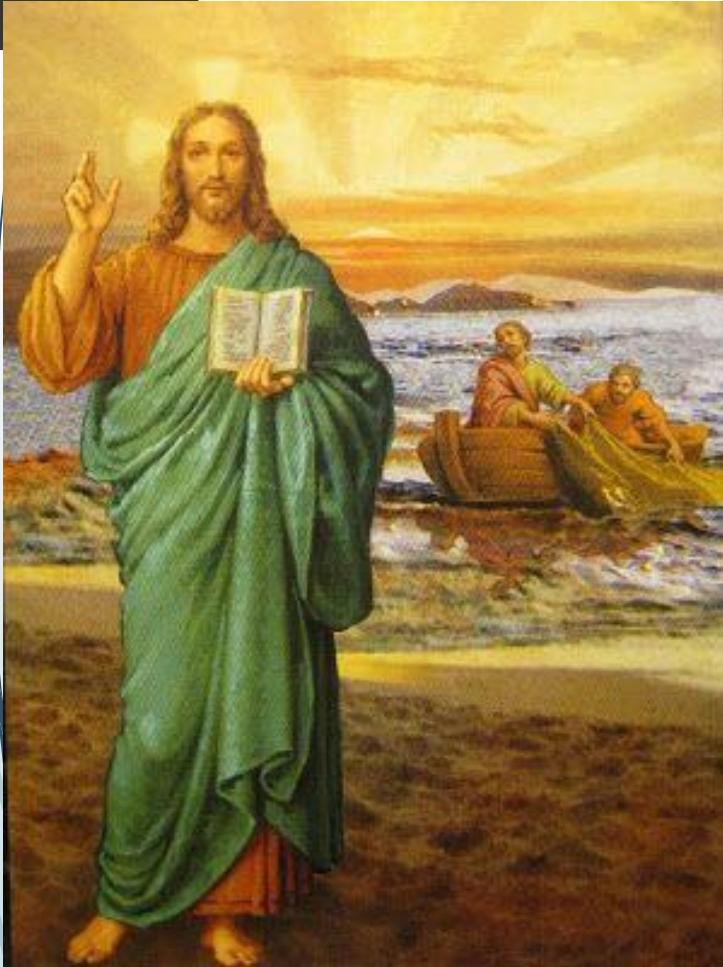

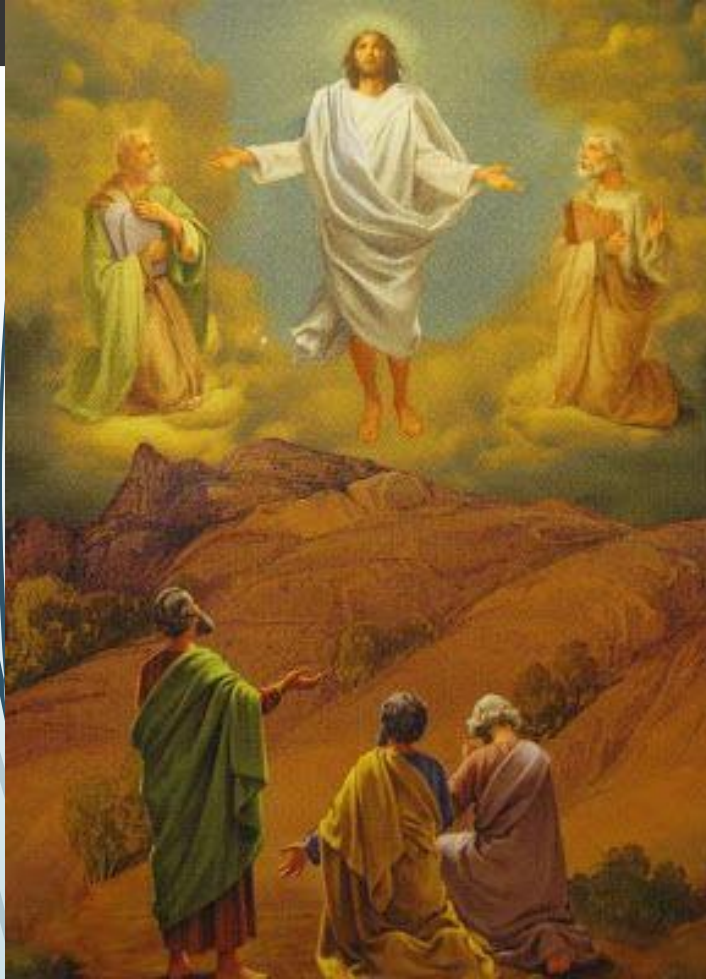
